"Emerging Lines" is an international interdisciplinary project, which promotes talented art and design students from the cities of Paris, Berlin, Wrocław and Riga through a series of exhibitions.

The project is a cooperation of the CROUS de Paris, the studierendenWERK Berlin, the Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław and the Art Academy of Latvia in Riga. Every city hosts one exhibition with artists from the partner cities. The first exhibition took place in Paris in January 2019. The second - in Berlin in April 2019.

The NEON Gallery of the Eugeniusz Geppert Academy of Art and Design in Wrocław presents the third exhibition EMERGING LINES #3, which features the artists:








