## Hospital Referral Trips

Single trip for 15 community members to Bushbuckridge hospital.

3500 ZAR including transportation and administration. Multiply by 4 trips the total will be 13 600 ZAR.

These are funds that the children and community members will need during and after the medical team's visit.

Optometrist consultation 800 ZAR per person

Basic eye tests 450 ZAR per person

Spectacles (frame and lenses) package 1500 ZAR per person.

Dentist consultation and removal of a single tooth 800 ZAR per person.

Filling of teeth in children plus consultation 1000 ZAR per person.

The above-mentioned medication and hospital referral trips will be needed during and after the medical team's visit to the Swa Vana centres. The funds raised will need to cover medical needs for the community members and beneficiaries until the next medical team's visit in 2027.

These will need to cover three centres across three communities. 449 beneficiaries and around 200/300 community members.
